#### From the Editor

I would like to introduce Tad Boehmer, Curator of Rare Books at the Main Library of Michigan State University. Recently, I asked about the Samaritan Collection and received a response form Mr. Boehmer. Tad, as he likes to be called has been very helpful. The <u>university posts</u> the following information:

Tad Boehmer joined the MSU Libraries in 2017 as Special Collections Cataloger within the Cataloging and Metadata Services and curator of fine press and alternative press materials for Special Collections. In November, 2018 Tad became the curator of rare books in Special Collections and continues his Special Collections Cataloger within the Cataloging and Metadata Services.

Before coming to MSU, Tad worked as a graduate assistant and project cataloger at the Rare Book & Manuscript Library at the University of Illinois, where he also helped to organize exhibitions and other programming, as well as assisting with patron services.

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Tad has a BA in Art History and Classics from Grinnell College, an MLS from the University of Illinois, and an MA in Religious Studies, also from the University of Illinois. He has completed coursework at the University of Virginia Rare Book School, where he also worked on the summer staff, including as the William Reese Fellow in the Print Culture of the Americas.

Most Samaritan scholars and researchers know the name <u>Rev. William Eleazar Barton</u> (1861-1930). His cousin, <u>Clarissa Harlowe Barton</u> (December 25, 1821 – April 12, 1912) was a pioneering American nurse who founded the <u>American Red Cross</u>.

A Clarification by Solomon Schechter (Cambridge University)

'The marginal note refers us to Sanhedrin 104a, where we shall certainly find the word *Cuti*, as the Hebrew for Samaritan. But we should have imagined that the veriest tyro in Talmudic study was aware that the word Samaritan, or *Cuti*, is one of the various expressions which an all scrupulous censorship has substituted for the genetic term *Nokri*, or foreigner. *Nokri* might possibly, so the censor believed, refer to Christians, hence *Cuti*, or Samaritana, which could not allude to Christians, was a convenient alternative. Whether the substitution changed the meaning of a passage or turned it into nonsense was a matter of the most trifling insignificance to the censor. In the present instance Dr. Edersheim might have been saved from his elementary mistake if he had glaced at the passage in Isaiah which is the basis and authority for the churlish statement in the Talmud. Isaiah (39.1-8) prophesies the captivity of Hezekiah's descendants because the king had shown courtesy and hospitality to the ambassadors of Merodach Baladan, the prince of Babylonia. This Merodach was a simple heathen and no Samaritan: in the rare first edition of the Talmud, which escaped the censor's alterations, Dr. Edersheim will find that *Nokri* and not *Cuti* is the subject of the extract in question.'

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



One of 2000 copies. Title in Russian and German on the front wrapper, two title pages, table of contents, introduction and all captions in Russian and German. This is a small nice catalogue of almost all Oriental (eastern) fonts which press of Academy of Sciences of USSR has. Only very outdated fonts were not included as well as those of incomplete sets. Russian science has a long history of Oriental studies, and this fund was growing organically alongside other researches. Almost all pre-Revolutionary publications with usage of eastern fonts were printed by Academy's press. There are Sanskrit, Tibetan, Chinese, Japanese, Mongolian, Manchurian,

Kalmyk, Buryat, ancient Turkish, Uigur, Persian cuneiform, Avestan, Middle Persian, Jewish, Palmyra, Syrian, Estrangelo, Ethiopian, **Samaritan**, Arab, Persian, Armenian, Georgian, Egyptian hieroglyphs, Coptic and phonetic symbols for the transcription. With the growth of country's republics and their culture the number of such books was growing as well so this edition is an evidence of last days when Academy's press was a unique leader in the field of Oriental fonts in the world. The catalogue was timed with the 200th anniversary of Academy's press and the World Press Exhibition ("Pressa") in 1928 in Cologne (that year Soviet display was designed by El Lissitzky which became his highest achievements in this field). 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Tibåt Mårqe: The Ark of Marqe Edition, Translation, Commentary (Studia Samaritana) by Abraham Tal (Editor) 2019 publication, now available

Tibåt Mårqe is a collection of midrashic compositions, which, in the main, rewrites the Pentateuch, expanding its sometimes laconic presentation of events and precepts. Most of it aims at providing the reader with theological, didactic and philosophical teachings, artistically associated with the passages of the Torah. Here and there poetic pieces are embedded into its otherwise prosaic text. Tibåt Mårqe is attributed to the 4th century scholar, philosopher and poet, Mårqe.

This publication of Tibåt Mårqe follows the monumental Hebrew edition of Ze'ev Ben-Hayyim, Tibåt Mårqe, a Collection of Samaritan Midrashim (Jerusalem 1988), based on a 16th century manuscript. Though he recognized the precedence of an earlier manuscript, dated to the 14th century, Ben-Hayyim was compelled to prefer the former, given the fragmentary state of the latter. He printed its fragments in parallel with the younger one, to which his annotations and discussions chiefly pertain. With the recent discovery of a great portion of the missing parts of the 14th century manuscript, this edition endeavors to present the older form of the composition. The present book may be relevant to people interested in literature, language, religion, and Samaritan studies.
