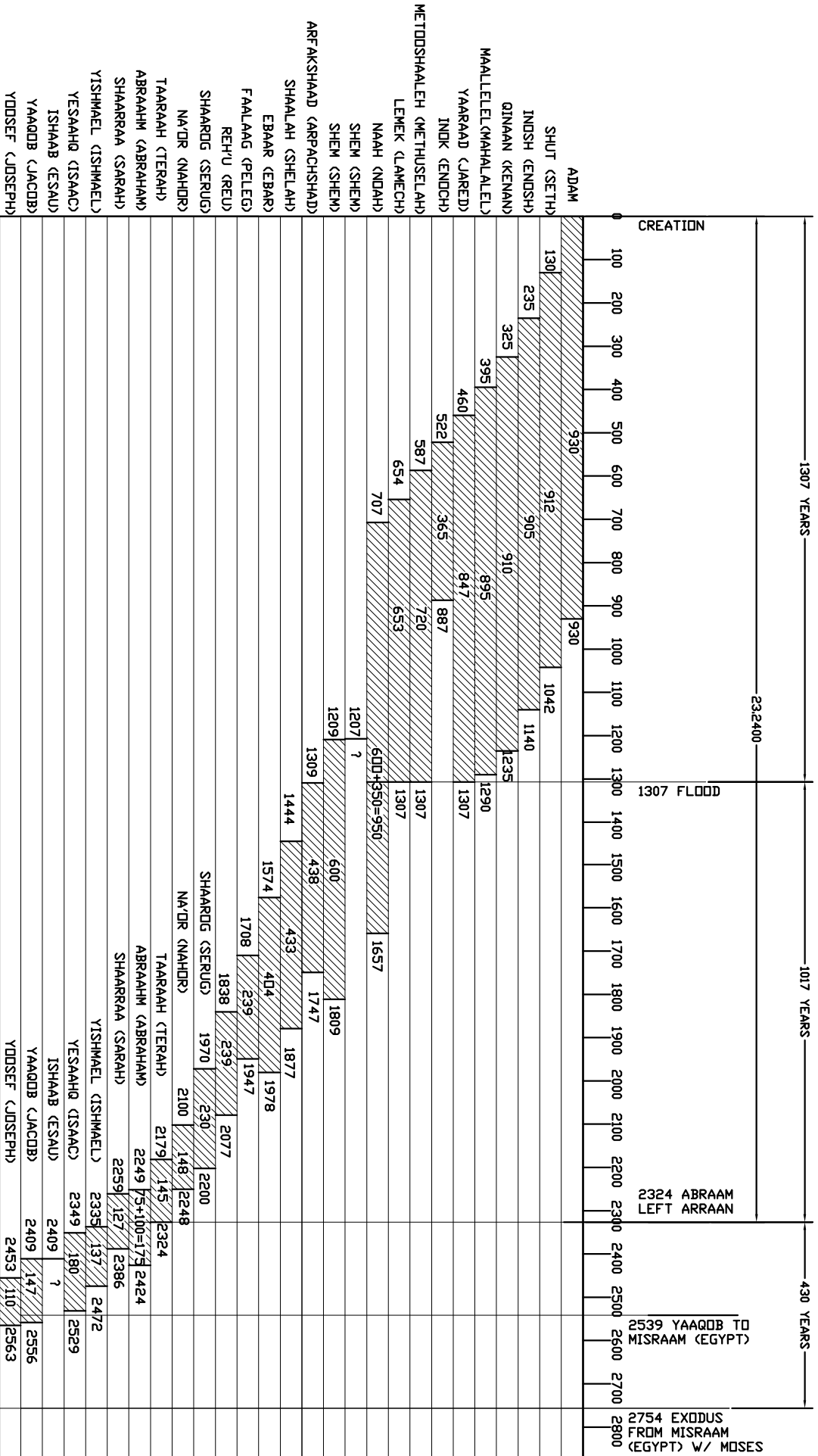


PATRIARCH LINEAGE FROM THE SAMARITAN-ISRAELITE TORAH

KEY: The years on the chart begin with Adam and are from the Samaritan-Israelite Torah. The first number indicates the year of birth, second number inside the shaded box indicates length of life. And the last number indicates the year of passing. The names are given as read by the Samaritan-Israelites and common names from the Bible

IMPORTANT NOTICE: THE YEARS SHOWN ON THIS CHART ARE AS SHOWN IN THE FIRST BOOK OF THE SAMARITAN-ISRAELITE TORAH COMMONLY KNOWN AS GENESIS (IN THE BEGINNING). SOME OF THE YEARS APPEAR TO BE ROUNDED OFF TO THE NEAREST 100. CASE IN POINT: SHEM WAS BORN IN THE 400TH YEAR OF THE LIFE OF NAAH (NDAH) (GEN. 5:32) AND THE FLOOD WAS IN THE 600TH YEAR OF THE LIFE OF NAAH (GEN. 7:6), THEREFORE SHEM WOULD HAVE BEEN 100 YEARS OLD AT THE TIME OF THE FLOOD. YET SHEM WAS 100 YEARS OLD 2 YEARS AFTER THE FLOOD (GEN. 11:10).
